A California NORML-sponsored bill (AB 1954; BPC 2228.5) protects the right of patients to medical treatment if they use marijuana, and the right of physicians and clinics to treat them. Under the law, doctors "shall not automatically deny treatment or medication to a qualified patient based solely on a positive drug

screen for THC or report of medical cannabis use without first completing a case-by-case evaluation of the patient."
